The first day to circulate nomination papers is December 1, 2025, and the final day for filing nomination papers is 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 6, 2026. Candidates for Justice of the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals Judge, District 4 file nomination papers and declarations of candidacy with the Wisconsin Elections Commission. Candidates for County Supervisor and Multi-Jurisdictional Judge file with the Sauk County Clerk's Office.


Primary Election
