Water Street Closure

Water Street south of Highway 12 will experience short-term closures starting the end of April through mid-May for continuing construction on the Great Sauk State Trail.

Leaf Pick up

The leaf machine will be out April 15th through May 15th, weather permitting. Anything not picked up by May 15th will need to be bagged.

Hydrant Flushing

The Village will begin flushing hydrants in April (weather permitting) and will continue flushing for a couple of weeks.

Park Shelter Rentals

The park shelter fees are \$30 for Monday-Thursday, and \$60 for Friday-Sunday for Meyer Oak Grove, Jaycee, Fuchs and Junge Parks. The price for renting the Riverfront Park shelter is \$100 for Monday-Thursday and \$200 for Friday-Sunday. This is the shelter south of the driveway across from the restrooms.
