Identifying Your Water Service Lateral Material! – **If** you received a letter from us saying that you have an Unknown service line material for your water line, please call us to report what that material is (i.e. copper, lead, galvanized). If you are not sure, call us at 643-3932 to schedule an appointment, where our utility staff will stop over to help identify the material. We are required to start updating our inventory with this information.

2026 DOG/CAT LICENSES

All dogs and cats in the Village 5 months of age or older are required to be licensed under Village ordinance. Licenses are \$10 for spayed or neutered; \$15 for all others. Proof of rabies vaccination is required. Please stop in the Village Hall or mail the check payable to Village of Sauk City **and include your rabies vaccinations certificate and a self-addressed return envelope**. Mail to 726 Water Street, Sauk City, WI 53583. Licenses are considered late after April 1st for that license year. A \$5 late fee is assessed for renewal licenses after April 1st.

PROPERTY TAX PAYMENTS

Your first installment (or to pay in full) is **due by January 31st** of each year and is sent to the Village of Sauk City. **We recommend mailing payments earlier than usual, as we were recently notified that the postal service has moved the postmark process from local application to regional sorting centers. After January 31st, all payments need to be mailed to Sauk County.** The second installment is due by July 31st to the Sauk County Treasurer.

WATER METER TESTING

There will be letters sent out to various residences to have your water meter tested. **If** you receive a letter to have your water meter tested, please call the village hall at 608.643.3932 to set up that appointment. These appointments take about 20 minutes and we will need to get into your basement to test the meter.

WINTER BRUSH PICKUP

Starting the 1st of January, the winter brush pick up will be the 1st and 3rd Thursday of every month. Following is the winter brush pick up schedule:

The regular weekly brush pickup will begin every Thursday on April 9th, 2026.

COMPOST PICKUP

Compost pick up is now done for the winter. Compost pick up will resume April 6, 2026 and will be collected every Monday.

SIGN UP FOR AUTOPAY WITH US, COMPLETELY FREE!

Sauk City Utilities gives you the option of having your monthly utility payment automatically withdrawn from your checking or savings account. The direct withdrawal is **FREE**. If you would like to choose this option, please let us know and we can send you a form to complete and return. Save money on postage, late charges, and cost of checks! Convenient – no last minute trips to drop off payment! Payments are withdrawn from your account **on or around the 23rd of the month**. If the 23rd falls on a Saturday, the amount will be taken out on Friday before. If the 23rd falls on a Sunday, the amount will be taken out the following Monday.

We also offer online payment options through the Payment Services Network. PSN charges a **\$3.30 convenience fee** for using this service. For the payment link, visit the Utility Payments section under Services on the Village website (www.saukcity.net).

Payments can be made in-person during our normal business hours (Monday-Friday 9am-4:30pm). They can also be dropped in our night drop box by the front entrance or mailed to Village of Sauk City, 726 Water St, Sauk City, WI 53583.
