

COMPOST & BRUSH PICKUP

COMPOST will be picked up every **MONDAY**.

Compost consists of yard clippings and garden waste. All compost shall be bagged in bio-degradable bags and placed on the tree bank by 7:00 AM and shall not weigh more than 40 pounds. Leave the bag open.

BRUSH will be picked up every **THURSDAY**.

Brush must be piled neatly with all ends placed toward the curb. Brush must be cut no larger than 3 inches in diameter, and 8 feet long. Place brush on the tree bank by 7:00 AM.

Residents who hire a contractor to cut their trees are responsible for their own removal.



Residents who wish to haul their own compost may do so anytime.

The Village has wood chips available for residents at no cost and you must haul the chips yourself. Contact the Village Office for more information.

Remember when raking your leaves/grass, always rake to the edge of the tree bank. Leaves /grass should never be raked into the gutter as it can clog the storm sewers.

Snow information

Parking- Snow



No parking on streets immediately following or during a snowfall of 2 inches or greater until streets are cleared.

Sidewalks- Snow

All sidewalks must be cleared of snow or ice within 24 hours after a snowfall has ended. If not cleared, the Village is authorized to have the sidewalks cleared and assessed to the property owner.

TRASH & RECYCLING

TRASH is picked up every week.

RECYCLING is picked up every other week.

Pickup days are Wednesday and Thursday, depending on where you are located in the Village. See map on our website.

Containers shall be placed at the curb the night before, or prior to 6:00 AM the morning of your pickup.



RECYCLING

Newspaper- Must be bundled and tied.

Corrugated & Glossy Cardboard- Must be flattened and tied.

Magazines- tied securely.

Vehicle Batteries- Must exchange for new battery at business where purchased.

The following can be placed together in **clear** plastic bags:

Plastic containers #1 thru #7, Steel Containers, Glass Containers, Bi-metal Containers & Aluminum Containers.

DOGS & CATS-

Annually on January 1st of each year, the owner of any dog/cat shall license their pet. Licenses can be purchased at the Sauk City Village Office with proof of rabies vaccination. Late fees are assessed after April 1st. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.
